- Cared less for each father figure

-mother hold him down

2] Warren's description of Theodore

-ineffective

-quiet

-shy

-devoted to Mrs. Burden

-commands little respect

3] THREE things Jack remembers in Chapter 3

-Ellis Burden leaves for Arkansas

-Anne Stanton's face
