

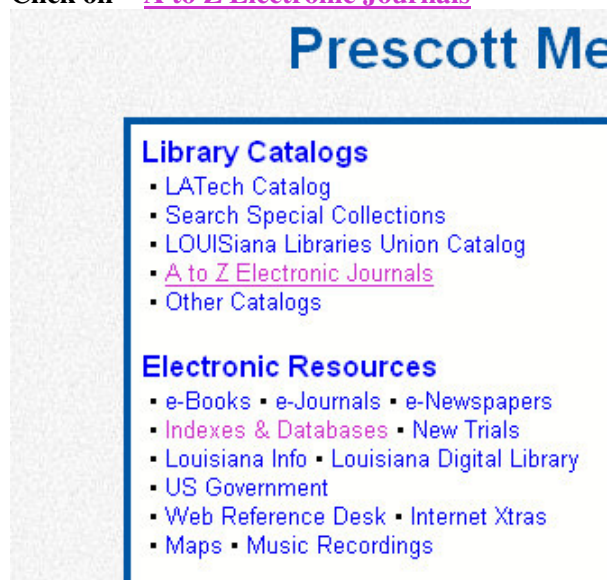
Here are the guidelines for the paper, which is a review of a scholarly article.

1. Find a scholarly article.
 - a. Do NOT look it up through Google or some other general search engine.
 - b. Go to the Tech home page.
 - c. Click on the [Library](#) link.
 - d. Click on the [Indexes & Databases](#) link.
 - e. Click on the [MLA International Bibliography](#).
 - f. If you are off campus, log in with your student id and the password (the default password is [changeme](#)).
 - g. Look up an article on one of the works that we are reading this quarter.
2. Download the article. You need to send it to me along with your paper.
3. Read the article.
4. Write a review.
 1. It should be 2+ pages long (not 1 1/2).
 2. About two thirds of the review should be summary of what the article says.
 3. The last third should be your response.
 4. Write the bibliographical information for the article in good MLA form.
5. Send the REVIEW AND THE ARTICLE to me.

How to find a scholarly article using JSTOR.

Some of you may have trouble finding an article through the MLA database that is available in electronic form. If that is the case, try the JSTOR (Journal STORAGE) database.

10. Save the article to your hard drive.

11. Attach it to your e-mail to send it with your article.
